50 Years of IMTEX and Counting

Indian Machine Tool Manufacturers' Association (IMTMA) celebrated 50 years of its flagship IMTEX exhibition during 'IMTEX 2019 & Tooltech 2019' held at Bangalore International Exhibition Centre (BIEC) in Bangalore from 24th January 2019 to 30th January 2019. The exhibition which featured 1222 exhibitors from 26 countries and attracted a footfall of 91,446 visitors was a resounding success. Business orders worth Rs. 2,446 Crores and enquiries worth Rs. 23,780 Crores were generated. Booked orders increased by 46% and enquiries generated increased by 25% as compared to IMTEX 2017 & Tooltech 2017. A series of new initiatives unravelled during the exhibition were well received by the manufacturing fraternity. IMTEX 2019 & Tooltech 2019 opened doors for manufacturing industries to embrace new age technologies and become competitive at the global level.

Experience Zone

To commemorate IMTEX 50 years' journey IMTMA set up an Experience Zone adjacent to Hall 4 in BIEC. The Experience Zone showcased vintage machines from a bygone era, pictures and a short film on IMTEX 50 years' journey.





New Initiatives at IMTEX 2019 & Tooltech 2019

Foreign Media Presence

A group of 9 journalists from various countries were invited to IMTEX 2019. The objective of the visit was to acquaint them with Indian machine tool and manufacturing industries and broadcast the opportunities in India overseas. At IMTEX the foreign media professionals interacted with the office bearers of IMTMA.



International General Managers' Meet

IMTMA hosted the first International General Managers' meeting coinciding with IMTEX 2019. The meeting provided an apt platform for the industry to exchange ideas, share knowledge and network. The meeting was a successful forum for a productive discussion and dialogue between machine tool associations for mutual benefit.



Eco Design Awards

Eco Design Award was initiated to promote sustainable lifecycle practices in exhibitions that balance quality, environment and economics with compliance to health and safety obligations. Six companies were conferred with awards in various categories. Ace Micromatic Group, Dynascan Inspection Systems Company, ETA Technology, Manar Tools, Taegu Tec India, and THK India were conferred awards.



Additive Manufacturing and Factory of the Future (Industry 4.0) are seen as technologies heralding a new era in manufacturing. IMTMA had special pavilions and seminars on these during the event.

Seminar on Additive Manufacturing

To familiarize Indian manufacturing with the techno-commercial advantages of additive manufacturing, IMTMA organized a Seminar on Additive Manufacturing at BIEC on 26 and 28 January 2019. The seminar attracted 110 delegates. The pavilion on Additive Manufacturing featured 21 exhibitors.





Factory of the Future (Industry 4.0)

The seminar on Factory of the Future (Industry 4.0) held on 25 January 2019 at BIEC presented a global and Indian outlook of Industry 4.0 offering a holistic understanding of the importance of IT infrastructure, data security and internet of things. The seminar was attended by 200 delegates. The pavilion on Factory of the Future featured 32 exhibitors.

Industry 4.0 is the biggest shift in manufacturing world since automation. Industry 4.0 is slated to modernize manufacturing and boost industrial competitiveness. To enhance their competitive edge and be on par with global players it becomes imperative for Indian players to be a part of this revolution. Engineers working in the field need to have a clear roadmap on which technologies to adopt to benefit their organizations. At IMTMA Technology Centre, a model smart factory has been set up where CNC Turning Centre, CNC Machining Centre, Digital Height Gauge and CMM machines were digitally connected and monitored in real-time. The real time data is being acquired through the data acquisition devices and CNC controls.

International Seminar on Machining Technologies

Potential buyers of machine tools from target overseas markets were invited to explore mutual business opportunities with the Indian machine tools and accessories manufacturers. Forty-eight international buyers from 13 countries such as Czech Republic, Russia, Indonesia, Iran, Italy, Mexico, South Africa, Ukraine and Vietnam, amongst others, participated at this Meet.





i2 Academia Pavilion

A record 50 institutions (33 outstation ones including IIT-Kanpur and IIT-Bombay and 17 Bangalore based institutions) participated in the i2 Academia Pavilion held during IMTEX. At IMTEX 2019 IMTMA provided an opportunity for Indian Academic / R&D institutions to showcase their R&D capabilities in metalworking field.



Connect and Quiz Contest

IMTMA organized an inter-college Quiz Contest on manufacturing technology as part of its Connect event at IMTEX 2019 for mechanical engineering students in BIEC. The Quiz facilitated the students to understand, get acquainted with latest technologies emerging in manufacturing industry, and make them competitive and industry-ready.
