NHAI Vehicular Underpass

The underpass which is scheduled to be completed by May 2018 will give motorists a hassle free entry into BIEC campus.

Bangalore Metro has begun construction work for the elevated corridor from Nagasandra to BIEC. Bangalore Metro Rail Corporation is building 3 stations in the line Manjunathanagar, Jindal and BIEC Terminal stations. The construction is scheduled to be completed in mid-2019.




New Hall 5



Construction of Hall 5 is in progress. In the first phase, flooring for the hall has been completed and we expect the hall to be ready by July 2018. This hall will be identical to Hall 4 with 75 mts. span and 235 mts. length. With completion of Hall 5 construction, BIEC will have a gross space of around 77,000 sq.mts.
